- Nominee should exhibit role model qualities including community service, business acumen and the ability to overcome obstacles.
- Award winner must be able to attend the 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Celebration of Achievement on May 6.

- A photograph of the nominee, electronic hi-res, print quality jpg (300 ppi at a print size of approximately 8" x 12").
- A brief professional biography between 150 and 180 words.
- Answers to the questions listed on the next page, with responses limited to one page or less per question.
- "Woman Business Owner of the Year Application" in the subject line of your email submission.

### **Application Questions**

1. Basic Information:

Name, Company, Address, Phone, Fax, Email, Percentage of Ownership, Annual Revenue, Number of Employees, Year Founded/Became Owner, Number of Family Members involved in the business, Type of Entity (Sole Proprietor, Partnership, S Corp, or C Corp.).

- 2. Provide a brief description of your business.
- 3. What motivated you to start your business?
- 4. Did you have to overcome any obstacles to start or grow your business?
- 5. What creative initiatives have you taken to make your business successful?
- 6. What qualities do you possess that have led to your success as a business owner? Describe the most satisfying aspect of ownership.
- 7. What were your gross revenues for the past three years? Also, explain growth in other areas, such as number of employees, increased customer base, etc.
- 8. List past and present involvement in civic, charitable, business and professional organizations, including service on their boards and/or committees.
- 9. Please describe a specific contribution you have made to any of the organizations.
- 10. What awards/honors have you received?
- 11. What are your major achievements as a business owner, community or business leader?
- 12. Describe why other women business owners might consider you a role model.
