VIRTUAL CHAPTER (Voting) \$49.95 monthly or (Non-Voting) \$39.95 monthly

If you don't have a chapter within 45 miles of your place of business, you can join us as a Virtual Premier or Basic Member. Membership features exclusive virtual events, meet-ups and other programming, including Virtual Connect & Learns on the second Thursday of every month and Virtual Mastermind groups to facilitate peer-to-peer support. Virtual voting members directly impact the current and future movement of the organization with its policies and processes. Voting members have one (1) vote and are under the supervision of NAWBO. They receive all the same benefits as Premier members.

SUPPORTING (Non-Voting) \$76.25 monthly

Supporting members include individuals who are not women business owners but who want to support and be part of NAWBO's mission through membership. They receive all the same benefits as Premier members. To qualify, the member does not need to be a woman business owner.
